The animal protection association "4 Paws" told us about your organization this morning. We did not know.

We, as a French animal protection association, strongly believe that whenever in Europe we have vaccines for Dogs and Cats that are identical in all respects (strains, adjuvants, excipients,...), then these vaccines cannot be subject to a different duration of immunity in different member states following pharmaceutical companies decisions rather than national prophylaxis policies. That is contrary to interests of protecting the health of our dear Companions.
